Ashley Obrest– Head Coach

After graduating from Boston College in 2007, Obrest served as the assistant coach at Concordia University Chicago for one season. Following a one-year stint as the assistant coach at Concordia, Obrest then moved on to Colgate University where she served as the

assistant coach for two years before being promoted to the head coach in July 2010. The 2011 season saw the Elmwood Park, Ill. native set a school record for most wins by a first year head coach (27) and led the Raiders to a regular season Patriot League title with a 16-3 conference mark. In her first campaign, Obrest guided Boston College to its first 20-win season in five years. The new skipper guided the Eagles to their best start in the previous decade, winning 10 of the first 12 games, before finishing with a 23-30 record. BC was victorious in games versus NCAA tournament teams, including the first defeat of a nationally ranked team (UNC) in three seasons. Under Obrest's tutelage, junior Nicole D'Argento pitched and hit her way to 1st Team All-ACC honors. In 2013, Tory Speer was named to the All-ACC 2nd Team as well as breaking the single season BC homerun record with 15 long balls. Megan Cooley set the single season stolen base record with 31 steals.



Hannah Jackson– Assistant Coach

Angel arrives at BC after being an assistant coach at Brown University last year. Prior to her stint at Brown, Angel was the head coach at Division III Emmanuel College. Angel also spent two years as an assistant softball coach at Simmons College in Boston,

Mass., prior to working at Emmanuel. A 2009 graduate of the University of North Carolina-Greensboro, Angel left UNCG being ranked third all-time in strikeouts, and was a member of the 2008 Southern Conference All-Tournament

Team. In 2008-09, she was in the Southern Conference Top 5 in ERA, wins, innings pitched and strikeouts.

Melissa Dubay– Volunteer Assistant Coach

Melissa joined Boston College as an assistant coach in the summer of 2013. Dubay was previously an assistant softball coach at Brandeis

University from 2009-13. From 2005-09 Dubay started at shortstop for Boston University. During here four years she was named to the America East Championship All-Tournament Team, earned America East Softball All-Conference honors three times, and made the Louisville Slugger Northeast second team.



John Pandolfo– Assistant Coach

John Pandolfo joined the Boston College softball team in August of 2013. For the six years prior to BC, Pandolfo was the assistant coach for the New Jersey Intensity program. Three of his daughters- Maria '13, Angela '09, and Danielle '10 all played at BC and were captains during their career.
